

Law Enforcement Involvement  
At Humane Society of Henderson County  
Policy

Law enforcement involvement at the Humane Society of Henderson County is for emergency situations only. Law enforcement can only be called with approval of the Executive Director or an Executive Member of the Board of Directors. The only exception to this will be in events of extreme emergency, such as serious verbal and physical threats to the safety of the animals, staff, volunteers or visitors.

General policy prohibits law enforcement involvement in matters that are not extreme emergency because it does not promote good business practice. The Humane Society of Henderson County provides a valuable service to the community by protecting the health and well being of domestic companion animals in Henderson County. The organization cannot approve employees calling the police for organizational problems without administration being aware of the issue and determining whether police involvement is actually required. The only exception to this is in cases of extreme emergency.

Employees who violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
